# City of Fall River, *In City Council*

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Fall River, that the Revised Ordinances of the City of Fall River, Massachusetts, 1999, be amended as follows:

By inserting in Section 62-2, which relates to Collection and disposal generally, a new subsection:

(c) The department shall collect solid waste and recyclables from single family dwellings and multiple family residential buildings containing up to six dwelling units. Solid waste shall be made on a weekly basis in areas designated by day, unless such collection is waived by the director. Solid waste shall be collected only if placed in plastic bags approved by the director. No bag shall be collected if its weight exceeds the weight limit for that bag. No solid waste shall be collected by the department from inside dwelling units or garages or any place other than the curbside area specified in this chapter.
