

PUBLIC NOTICE

UTILITY DEMAND FEES

The Fall River Department of Community Utilities with the City's Financial Team is instituting a program of DEMAND NOTICES AND FEES for late payment of water and sewer bills.

For each bill that is not paid within 30 days; the customers shall be sent a demand notice with an additional fee of \$5.00 for water and \$5.00 for sewer as applicable.

At the end of the year, bills that remain unpaid shall be liened against the property tax bill and the remainder of the lien fees up to \$30 for water and \$30 for sewer shall be applied.

This program is intended to improve cash flow and collections. The majority of our customers pay their bills on time. This program is intended for those customers that do not pay on time.

The demand fees are in accordance with Sections 74-138 and 74-363 of the existing ordinances.
